1	Stellenbosch <b>D'ouwe Werf</b>		Participants will be collected either from Cape Town International Airport or from the hotel in Cape Town where they will have been staying before the commencement of this private tour
			Depart for the "Boland" (the Cape Winelands region)
	Oak Apartments		Towns that will be visited today include Paarl (famous for its "Taalmonument" commemorating the Afrikaans language), and Stellenbosch (second oldest European town in South Africa, famous for its Cape Dutch architecture)
			Lunch not included
			Wine-tastings will be included at two of the country's best wine estates, offering you the opportunity to taste and buy some of the best of South African wines
		<b>D</b>	Evening return transfer to Spier Estate for a Buffet Dinner at Moyo's Treetop (space permitting)
2	Montagu	<b>B</b>	After breakfast at the lodge we drive via Franschhoek, the Huguenot town in the valley with the same name, where protestant refugees from France settled in the second half of the 17th century, after fleeing religious persecution in France, bringing with them the art of winemaking
	<b>Mimosa Lodge</b>		The town's main street offers various sidewalk cafés, where you could sit down for coffee, as well as art galleries and even a "chocolaterie", with the imposing Huguenot Memorial at its top-end
			We continue via the Franschhoek Pass and Villiersdorp to Robertson and visit Excelsior Wine Estate, where clients will be shown how to make their own blend out of single cultivar red estate wines
	Garden Suite <b>3 - 5 June (minimum 2 nights' stay), therefore a supplement would apply over these dates - please enquire</b>	<b>L</b>	This will be followed by a very light picnic lunch, where a basket with breads, cheeses and some cold meats can be enjoyed in private next to the dam (weather permitting) together with a bottle of one's own blend or one of the estate's wines
			From here we continue to Montagu, a gateway to both Route 62 and the Little Karoo beyond
		<b>D</b>	Gourmet dinner served at the lodge

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3	Little Karoo region  <b>Swartberg Country Manor</b>	<b>B</b>	After breakfast we continue further on Route 62 (an alternative wine route through the mountains) with various quaint villages, towns and farm-stalls along the way
			As there is no rush to get to our next destination at the foot of the Swartberg Mountains, we will have time to stop off at some of the attractions along the way, maybe have some coffee and cake at one of the hospitable small-town coffee shops, or just appreciate the surrounding mountains
			Lunch not included
			After checking in at our overnight destination, we leave for a late afternoon guided visit to an ostrich farm (included)
		<b>D</b>	A dinner "braai" (BBQ) with ostrich fillet is included here, rounding off this experience
			Return to the hotel after dinner
4	Little Karoo region <b>Swartberg Country Manor</b>	<b>B</b>	Breakfast at the hotel
			Morning guided visit to the Cango Caves (included)
			The rest of the day is at leisure to just relax or partake in any of a number of optional activities offered at the lodge, e.g. a Swartberg Mountain Pass excursion or a visit to the so-called "Hell"
			No lunch is included
		<b>D</b>	Dinner included at the hotel
5	Sedgefield  <b>Lake Pleasant Living</b>  1-bedroom suites  <i>Festive season surcharge (21 Dec - 11 Jan) applies - please enquire</i>	<b>B</b>	Breakfast at the hotel
			This morning we drive onto the famous Garden Route, but first via the town of Oudtshoorn, then over the Outeniqua Pass and George to the beautiful beach of Wilderness
		<b>L</b>	We enjoy a light lunch en route, before continuing past Sedgefield to the Groenvlei Dam, where our accommodation is situated
			Enjoy the relaxing surrounds, make use of the spa facilities, enjoy the peace and tranquility here until your guide fetches you mid-morning the following day again
			Dinner can be enjoyed at your own expense at the in-house bistro

			Continue on the N2 past Plettenberg Bay to your lodge, surrounded by indigenous forest, in the region known as "The Craggs"	
			Your tour guide and vehicle will be available to take you to town if you wish to eat something there away from the lodge, which is otherwise secluded in its mountainous surroundings

			Morning visit to Tsitsikamma Reserve (conservation fees included), where you have the option of venturing into indigenous forest by taking any of a number of short walking trails, e.g. one to the mouth of the Storms River	
			The rest of the day is at leisure to do any of a number of optional activities offered in the region	
			You could also opt for a walk in the indigenous forest directly on the hotel's doorstep
